

## Rental of Suitable Clothes for Dog Sled Trips

This list is an addition to our winter packing list.

Even on a shorter one-hour dog sled ride, it can get cold when sitting on a sled. It is possible to rent sealskin clothes or other warm clothes and warm boots for the sledding trip in most places. If you do not have very warm clothes yourself, we recommend that you rent sledding equipment. Actually, it is an experience to try the "original" sledding equipment.

Be sure to check whether the dog sledding clothes and boots are included in the price of the dog sled ride you have chosen. If in doubt, contact Greenland Travel.

## Packing List if You Go on Dog Sledding Tours One Day or Longer

Large bag (approx. 20 liters)		Soft material. You will sit on your luggage during the sled ride.
	Small backpack/day bag	For the equipment to be used during the day. The backpack is attached to the sled's driving handle.
Min. four pairs of socks		Two pairs to wear and two pairs as spares. We recommend pure wool.
One set of sweat transporting underwear (thin)	Possibly an extra set.	
One set of sweat transporting underwear (heavy)	Possibly an extra set.	
One pair of mittens		Large enough to have thin fingertips under them.
Two pairs of gloves	Two extra pairs	We recommend pure wool.
Hat	Possibly an extra hat	Windbreaking material is a good choice.
